The Venous Forum (VF) is pleased to announce an VF Research PUMP Priming Grant to a maximum value of (£10,000) for a candidate to initiate /commence a research project in phlebology.

The grant is open to trainee/specialists under 40 years of age at time of application

To apply, the candidate needs to supply:

- a) Up to a 1000 word application outlining the research costs and aim of the potential benefit of the research to the phlebology and endovenous world.
- b) Curriculum Vitae.
- c) Letter from their Head of Department and/or a senior colleague/specialist, supporting the application.

Closing date of application: Wednesday 1st April 2009.

The successful candidate will be announced during the Annual General Meeting of the VF in April 2009. The winner will be expected to attend the 2010 Spring meeting of the Venous Forum and present their work in a 10 minute presentation
