

AIRLINES WHICH FLY TO BALICE FROM THE UK AND IRELAND

- Aer Lingus - from Dublin
- British Airways - from London Gatwick
- EasyJet - from Belfast, Bristol, Edinburgh, Liverpool, London Gatwick, Luton, Newcastle
- Jet2 - from Leeds-Bradford
- LOT Polish Airlines (via Frankfurt) - from Birmingham, Dublin, Edinburgh, London Heathrow
- Ryanair - from Birmingham, Dublin, Edinburgh, Glasgow Prestwich, Liverpool, London Stanstead, Shannon

A taxi into Krakow should cost around 50PLN (approx £11) and take around 20mins.

Wizz Air flies into Katowice Pyrzowice Airport which is 100km from Krakow. They fly from Cork, Liverpool, Luton, Robin Hood (Doncaster-Sheffield)
Transfers to Krakow are available for around £40 and would take an hour.

ACCOMMODATION

The main conference hotel will be the Sheraton situated on the edge of the Old Town and facing both the river and Wawel Castle.

Sheraton (5 stars)

It is very central and an ideal location to act as a hub for our trip; only 15 minutes walk from the conference venue, Auditorium Maximum.
