

## **DR JOHN SCADDING**

Dr John Scadding is honorary consultant neurologist to the National Hospital for Neurology and Neurosurgery, London. Previously, he was consultant neurologist at the National and Whittington Hospitals, honorary Senior Lecturer at the Institute of Neurology, and honorary consultant neurologist to the Royal Navy, the Royal Air Force, the Royal Society of Musicians, and St Luke's Hospital for the Clergy. He has a career-long clinical and research interest in the mechanisms and treatment of chronic pain related to neurological disease.

He was Medical Director of the National Hospital for Neurology and Neurosurgery and subsequently, Deputy Medical Director of the UCLH NHS Trust. He is a member of the Strategy and Development Group of the James Lind Alliance, a Trustee and member of the Board of Management of the Royal Hospital for Neuro-disability, Putney, and a Trustee of The Cure Parkinson's Trust and Chairman of its Research Committee.

He was Clinical Sub-Dean at the Institute of Neurology in the 1980s, and has held visiting Professorships in Malaysia and Hong Kong. He was Associate Dean of the RSM from 2002 to 2006 and Dean from 2006 to 2008. He is Emeritus Dean, and since October 2008, has been Chairman of RSM Press.
