Susan Horsewood-Lee studied in London, Cambridge, Oxford and South Africa to become a General Practitioner in 1979. Her NHS career in Kensington was in a group practice and included undergraduate and postgraduate teaching and as a trainer.

Her medico political career began as President of the Royal Free Hospital Medical School and Chair of the London Medical Schools Association and Junior Hospital Doctors Association.

She subsequently works with the BMA on the Private Practice Committee and was on the General Medical Services Committee for three years

She set up the Primary Care Section of the Independent Doctors Federation and has sat on its Council from 1981 and campaigns for fair Regulation of the Profession.

Liason between the RSM and The Royal College of General Practitioners NW London Faculty Board membership goes back almost 30 years.

She has been a Council member of the RSM Primary Care Section since 2001 and is an active member of the Open Section, Obstetrics and Gynaecology Section and Paediatric sections.

She supports multi-disciplinary input to meetings of all sections and lay involvement. She is keen on multisource feedback at work and in wider academic settings with the GMC and the Royal Colleges.

Global initiatives in primary care and education especially in women's empowerment schemes for health and education in India, Pakistan and Africa are current. The RSM should continue to expand global links especially to support members working overseas.
