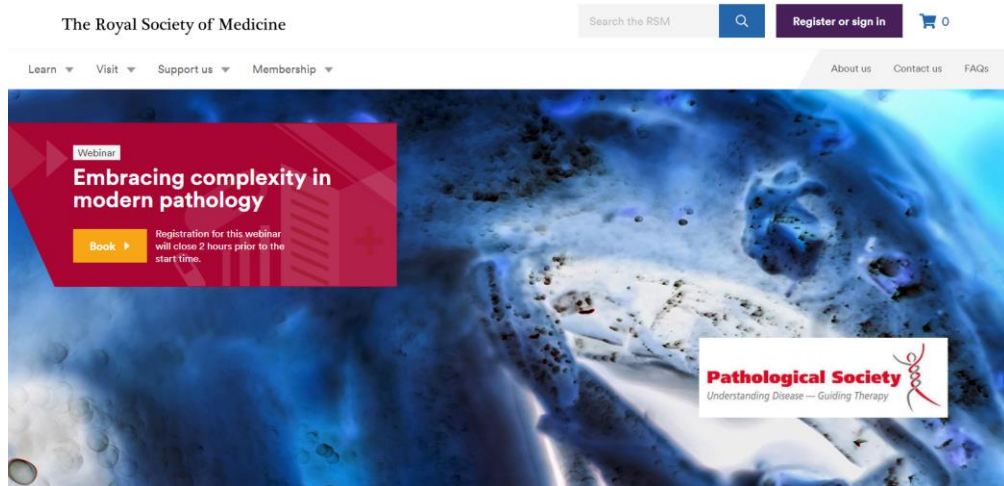


How to register for the joint RSM and Pathological Society 2022 winter meeting **Embracing complexity in modern pathology**
